Collegiate Aviation Progress Award Selection Criteria

Qualifications

- 1. In order to compete for the Collegiate Aviation Progress Award, a team must have competed in at least one prior national SAFECON for which individual scoring data is available.
- 2. For items 2 & 3, only scores from the same events can be used for comparison. If an event is not held or only partially completed at any SAFECON whose scores are being used for calculations, then those events cannot be considered from any other SAFECON in determining change for items 2 and 3.

Calculations

- 1. The change in a team's current SAFECON ranking compared with the previous two years rankings.
- 2. The change in the average team member's contribution to the team's total points compared to the last national SAFECON at which the team competed.
- 3. The cumulative change in average team member points for all of the following events compared to the last national SAFECON at which the team competed.
 - a. SCAN
 - b. Power Off
 - c. Short Field
 - d. Preflight
 - e. Computer Accuracy
 - f. Ground Trainer
 - g. Aircraft Recognition
 - h. Navigation
 - i. Message Drop
- 4. Ties shall be broken by comparing the change in average team member points for the events listed in item 3, on an individual basis beginning with event (a). The team with the greatest positive change will be declared the winner.
